NEW BRAKE MANUAL**A new brake manual to provide assistance to all employees**


Cologne, 16/02/2016 - Following its recent investment - the acquisition of Trusting and Fri.Tech. - Metelli S.p.A. continues its role as an active partner to its customers, through the creation of a new and updated technical manual for brakes. In this manual, the company provides a detailed explanation of the characteristics of the braking system: a system to which we entrust our safety every time we drive a vehicle, both under normal braking conditions and when making emergency stops.



At Metelli, each stage of the machining process is carefully planned and closely monitored, ensuring compliance with the highest quality standards. From the Research and Development laboratory, where new, improved materials are constantly being developed and tested, to the design phase, where the various structures and accessories are adapted to the specific conditions of our product, whilst respecting the original parameters. The production phases is subject to close scrutiny, and Metelli carries out rigorous quality controls on all materials and manufacturing processes, to ensure that the characteristics of each product are consistent with one another, and offer a high added value.

In the final part of the manual, instructions and tips are provided for assembling the various components correctly. Each operation regarding the replacement of a disc, a drum brake or even just the brake pads or shoes must be carried out with the utmost care, using the appropriate tools and ensuring that both the environment and person or persons involved are adequately protected. The braking system is crucial to safety, and as such, incorrect assembly of any one of its components could lead to less than optimum vehicle function, and potentially result in serious consequences for the safety of the car's driver and occupants.

In addition to this new technical manual, Metelli is also continuing to expand its range of products, with the introduction of **326** new items in 2015 alone, including 169 new brake discs, 81 new brake pads, 14 new drums and 62 new brake shoes, covering **1,864** applications. To date, Metelli's product offering is among the largest and most competitive on the market, with over 1,600 brake pads, 1168 brake discs, around 350 drums, 650 shoes and 220 rapid kits (this last figure is due increase to 436 in the near future).



The current range of brakes, which comprises around 4,000 separate products, in addition to the services that Metelli offers in terms of technical support and after-sales service, can meet an extensive range of customer needs, helping to identify the right product and to fit it correctly, confirming its role as a point of reference for professionals and operators in the automotive industry.
